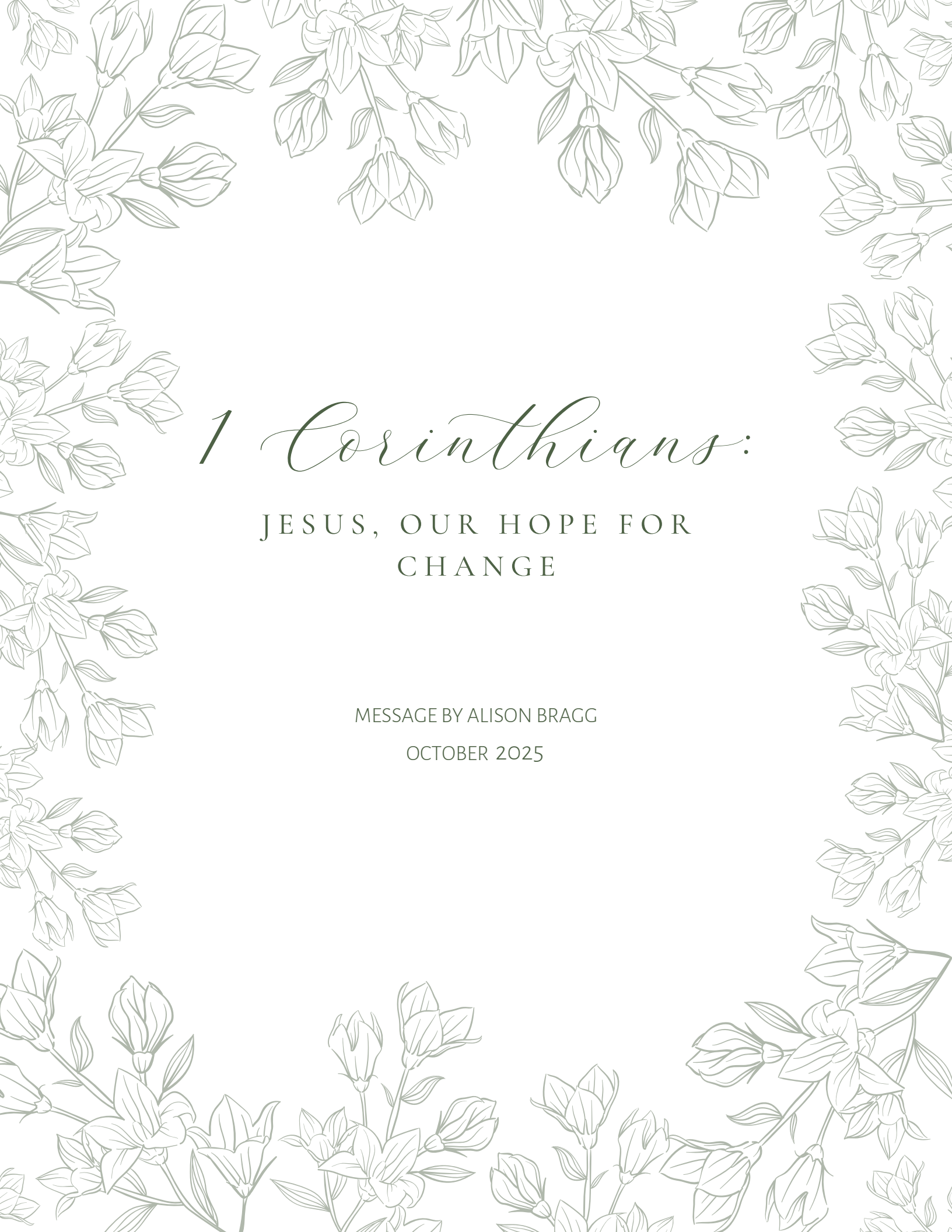

TO CONSIDER

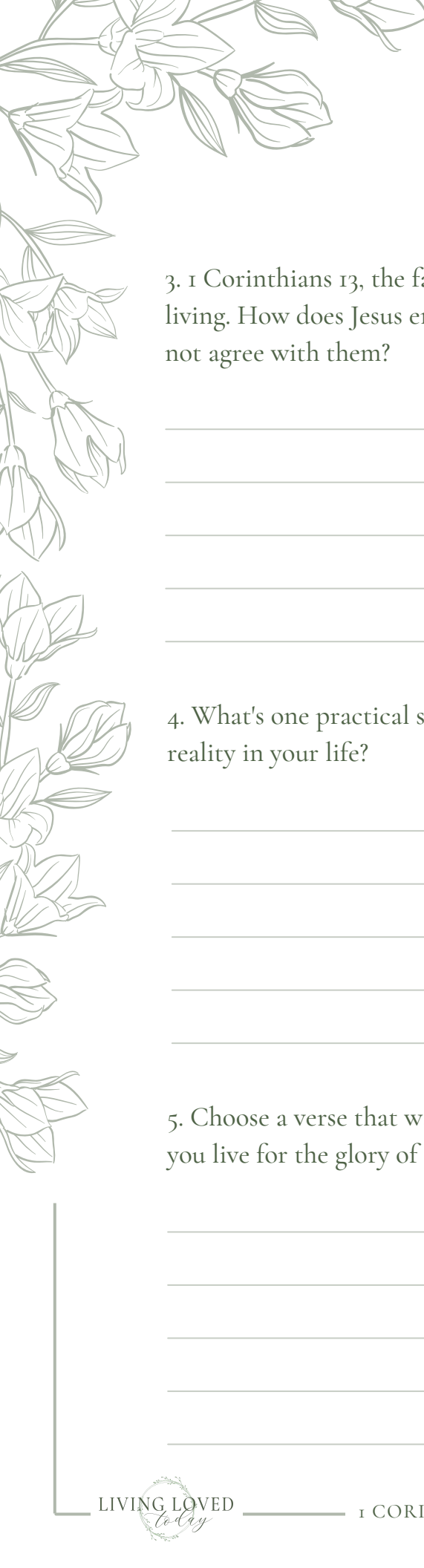
1. What stood out to you as you listened to the message today? How did it impact you and what did you learn?
